Re: **Therapeutic Passes and Covid 19**

Dear Parents and Guardians:

Grafton has taken many actions to prepare for the current pandemic, and values the health and safety of our residents above all else. That being said, we believe that therapeutic passes and family engagement are crucial parts of the services we provide and we hesitate to stop them until absolutely necessary.

PLEASE do not involve your child in public gatherings while on pass. This might include movies, skating, concerts, malls, etc.

PLEASE do not expose your child to anyone who is ill (specifically having an upper-respiratory virus and a fever of 99 degrees or higher)

PLEASE do not expose your child to anyone who has recently traveled in an area in which COVID 19 is actively spreading.

Upon return to Grafton, your child will be screened for illness. If he or she has symptoms we will advise you to take them to a medical provider of your choosing for screening prior to reintroducing them to our programs. We will not reintroduce any child who tests positive for Covid 19 to our programs.
