As discussed in the last letter (sent on November 25), we are following up to discuss the current plan for day students at Grafton's therapeutic day school programs. Given the consistently high level of community spread in the regions we serve, we are making the decision to **continue distance learning for all day students beyond January 4.**

We believe that the situation is becoming a bit less predictable, as a vaccine is becoming available shortly, and Virginia has taken steps to decrease community spread. As a result we will only extend this plan for **two weeks, ending January 18. We will notify you by Monday, January 11 at the latest about our plans to restart in-person learning.**

Grafton staff have continued to excel during this crisis – we have had no outbreaks within Grafton to date.
