As discussed in the last letter (sent on December 28), we are following up to discuss the current plan for day students at Grafton's therapeutic day school programs. Given the consistently high level of community spread in the regions we serve, **we will continue to provide a distance-learning option only until February 1 at the earliest.**

This is still an unpredictable situation – the vaccine is becoming available to our staff in some areas, but not others. Steps are being taken to mitigate the community spread, but the levels remain high. As a result we will only extend this plan for **two weeks, ending February 1. We will notify you by Monday, January 25 at the latest about our plans to restart in-person learning.**
